

2026 New Creation Chorus Membership Info

Purpose. *The structure and activities of New Creation Chorus are designed to promote the musical, spiritual, and social growth of its members. The programs presented by New Creation Chorus are designed to provide an opportunity for singer and listener to join together in worship of God through choral music sung skillfully, enthusiastically, and sincerely.* Members are expected to be attentive and active participants during rehearsals and be committed to learning the music well. Members are expected to promote group unity by interacting primarily with the broader group during chorus functions over special friends and friend groups.

Rehearsals

- **Opening Night:** Tuesday evening, May 26. All applicants are expected to attend. This will be a “meet & greet” night at Terre Hill Mennonite High School, including music distribution, part auditions, snack, and group activities.
- **Weekly rehearsals:** Tuesday evenings, June 2 - September 8 at Living Water Mennonite Fellowship or Terre Hill Mennonite High School. 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. with snack following.
- **Sunday rehearsals:** June 28 and July 26. These practices will start at 3:30 p.m. and will include afternoon and evening practice sessions. We ask all members to make these practices priority.
- **Weekend Retreat:** All members are expected to attend a chorus retreat planned for August 21-23, 7:00 Friday evening through ~1:00 Sunday afternoon. Mark your calendars!

Program Itinerary. (Itinerary will be distributed on opening night with music packets)

- **Local Programs:** Sunday evenings Sep. 13 - Nov. 15
- **Day Tour:** Sunday, Oct. 4 (morning and evening programs)
- **Tour:** Thu. Nov. 5 – Mon. Nov. 9

Attendance Policy.

- **Rehearsals.** Members are expected to attend rehearsals unless they have signed out on an online sign-out form at least one week in advance of an expected absence. Members are expected to miss no more than three rehearsals and should talk to the directors if anticipating needing to miss more than three.
- **Programs.** Members are expected to demonstrate their commitment to the chorus by attending **all** programs. Excusable reasons for missing a program include 1) significant immediate family-related events, 2) significant church-related obligations (e.g. communion), or 3) employment-related obligations. Members are expected to communicate with the directors ASAP if they are anticipating a program absence. Members shall plan to arrive for programs one hour and 15 minutes prior to program start times.

Personal Appearance. Members are asked to avoid overly casual attire for chorus functions and to present themselves in a manner consistent with the general practice of the Keystone Mennonite Fellowship. Jewelry of no kind shall be worn. **Men.** Men shall wear full length pants and shirts with collar or buttons. T-shirts are permitted only for recreational activities. **Ladies.** Ladies’ clothing shall be of modest design with skirt lengths extending below the knees. Hair shall be worn up and under an unadorned, white cap-style covering or veil aligning with the general practice of the Keystone Mennonite Fellowship congregations.

Miscellaneous Expectations. Chorus members are expected to provide a black music folder and pencil to be used during rehearsal season as well as to purchase their chorus program outfits. Members are expected to practice music and/or do singing exercises outside of group rehearsal as assigned.

Cost. A \$65 **non-refundable** membership fee is charged to cover music costs, building rental, bulletins, etc. Applicants are expected to pay this fee on opening night, May 26. Payment should be given to Lamar and Eden and can be made by cash, check (made out to New Creation Chorus), or PayPal (link will be provided). Lodging for retreat is estimated to be \$70 per person. Members will be invited to contribute toward tour expenses as they are able.

Application Process. Fill out the *online* application form by May 11. Contact Lamar Reiff for the link. Applicants must be at least 16 years of age on June 1. After reviewing your application, the chorus administrators will contact you regarding your membership. Space is limited so sign up early. Tours will be limited to a bus load (~50 chorus members). Chorus membership and tour participation may be determined by sign-up date, age, part sung, number of practices missed, and perhaps other factors.
